NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Sumner City Council will hold a public hearing at approximately 7:00 p.m. on Monday, October 19, 2009, in the City Council Chambers located in Sumner City Hall, 1104 Maple Street, Sumner, WA 98390. The City Council is considering taking a collective position on the ballot measure indentified below, that will be presented to the electorate during general election on November 3, 2009

Statewide Initiative Measure 1033 that concerns state, county and city revenue.

This measure would limit growth of certain state, county and city revenue to annual inflation and population growth, not including voter-approved revenue increases. Revenue collected above the limit would reduce property tax levies. Should this measure be enacted into law? Yes [] No []

All interested persons are invited to be present to voice approval, disapproval or opinions on whether the City Council should take a collective position on this ballot measure.

Note: RCW 42.17.130 prohibits the use of city facilities to assist in promotion of or opposition to any ballot proposition. However, RCW 42.17.130(1) allows the City Council to adopt a Resolution in support of or opposition to a ballot proposition if certain mandatory procedural steps are taken, including providing notice that the Council will discuss taking a collective position regarding the ballot measure, and providing an opportunity for public comment prior to Council action. The purpose of this notice is to comply with the provisions of RCW 42.17.130
