Sealed bids will be received by the City of Sumner in the Office of the City Clerk located on the second floor of Sumner City Hall, 1104 Maple Street, Suite 200, Sumner, Washington 98390-1423, until 2:00 p.m. on March 26th, 2009, as shown on the clock nearest to the desk of the City Clerk. Bids will thereafter be opened and publicly read aloud. Bids received after the time fixed for Bid Opening will not be considered.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a proposal guarantee (certified or cashier's check or approved bond) payable to the City of Sumner in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the proposal price. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Sumner.

The City of Sumner reserves the right to waive informalities in the bidding, accept a Proposal of the lowest responsible bidder, reject any or all bids, republish the Call for Bids, revise or cancel the work, or require the work to be done in another way if the best interest of the City is served.

The City of Sumner is an Affirmative Action/Equal Opportunity Employer and hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any Contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement disadvantaged business enterprises will be given the full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation. Plans and Specifications will also be available for purchase for a nonrefundable fee of \$75.00 for each set, (checks must be made payable to the City of Sumner). Over-the-counter purchases may be made at Sumner City Hall, Public Works Department, 1104 Maple Street, Suite 260, Sumner, WA 98390-1432. Purchases through the mail may be arranged by calling 253.299.5700. Informational copies of maps, plans, and specifications are also available for review at the above-mentioned location. **Prime Contractors submitting a Proposal must be included on the plan holders list, developed and maintained by the Owner. If a bidder is not registered on the City of Sumner's official plan holders list, then their bid may be considered as nonresponsive.**

The improvements for which bids will be received are described as follows:

Construction of a new 500 GPM duplex sewage pumping station including a wet well submersible pumps and associated piping, valves, and appurtenances; generator with noise enclosure; pump station electrical and controls; and general site work.

The contractor will have 150 calendar days to complete the work in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.
