Sealed bids will be received by the City of Sumner in the Office of the City Clerk located on the second floor of Sumner City Hall, 1104 Maple Street, Suite 200, Sumner, Washington, 98390-1423 until **2:00 p.m. on January 13, 2008**, as shown on the clock nearest to the desk of the City Clerk. Bids will therefore be opened and publicly read aloud. Bids received after the time above stated will not be considered.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to at least five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Sumner.

The City of Sumner reserves the right to waive informalities in the bidding, accept a Proposal of the lowest responsible Bidder, reject any or all Bids, republish the Call for Bids, revise or cancel the work, or require the work to be done in another way if the best interest of the City is served or if available funding is exceeded.

The City of Sumner is an Affirmative Action/Equal Opportunity Employer, and hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantage businesses enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation. Over the counter purchases may be made at Sumner City Hall, Public Works Department, 1104 Maple Street, Suite 260, Sumner, WA 98390-1432. Purchases through the mail will only be arranged by calling 253-299-5703.

The improvements for which bids will be received are described below:

Construction of approximately 2135 linear feet of asphalt paved trail in the City of Sumner beginning adjacent to Fryar Ave Bridge and terminating by the White River at Tacoma Street Bridge, by clearing and grubbing, grading, draining, surfacing, paving with commercial HMA, signing, constructing removable bollards and associated work as further specified and shown in the contract documents.

The contractor will have sixty (60) working days to complete the work in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.
