

CALL FOR BIDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by the City of Sumner, Washington at the office of the City Clerk, in Sumner City Hall, 1104 Maple Street, Sumner, WA 98390 up to the hour of **2:00 p.m. (as determined by the clock in the Clerks office) on Tuesday, August 28, 2007**, after which time all bids will be opened and publicly read aloud. Bids received after the time fixed for Bid Opening will not be considered.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in the form of a certified or cashier's check, postal money order, or surety bond made payable to the City of Sumner, for a sum not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid, including sales tax. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory payment and performance bonds within the time stated in the specifications, the bid deposit/bond shall be forfeited to the City of Sumner.

The City of Sumner reserves the right to waive informalities in the bidding, accept a proposal of the lowest responsible bidder, reject any or all Bids, republish the Call for Bids, revise or cancel the work, or require the work to be done in another way if the best interest of the City is served.

The City of Sumner is an Affirmative Action/Equal Opportunity Employer and hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any Contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement disadvantaged business enterprises will be given the full opportunity to submit Bids in respect to this invitation. 
Plans and Specifications will also be available for purchase for a **NON-REFUNDABLE fee of \$50.00** for each set, (Checks to be made out to the City of Sumner.) Over the counter purchase may be made at Sumner City Hall, Public Works Department, 1104 Maple Street, Suite 260, Sumner, WA 98390-1432. Contract plans and contract specifications will not be mailed.

The Work to be performed within 30 calendar days from the date of Notice to Proceed consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and other work or items incidental thereto for:

Construction of a stormwater conveyance system near the east end of Elm Street along with a line from Elm Street north to Salmon Creek, including approximately 520 feet of 30" concrete pipe, 464 feet of 24" concrete pipe, 447 feet of 18" concrete pipe along with the concrete structures along these lines and 200 feet of biofiltration swale. This work includes but is not limited to survey, traffic control, clearing, grubbing, trench excavation safety systems, base preparation, Asphalt concrete paving, pavement markings, and other work necessary to complete the Work as specified and shown in the Contract Documents.
