INVITATION TO BID

The City of Sumner is releasing a Small Public Works Project. As a contractor on the Small Works Roster (MRSC), you are invited to express interest on this project.

PROJECT TITLE: CIP 07-13, Sumner's Central Well (Fleischmann's Site Production Well)

Description of Work

The well will be drilled utilizing cable-tool methods only. The intent of the project is to land, at a minimum, 16-inch diameter casing at a depth of 550 feet. Flowing conditions are expected at the site, so drilling will commence with the installation of a 100 to 200 foot by 24-inch diameter flow-control seal. It is also anticipated that one casing reduction may be required to reach the targeted drilling depth, so drilling below the flow-control seal will commence with 20-inch diameter casing to facilitate one casing reduction if needed.
